- ◉ Clearly stated objectives or purposes
- ◉ Perspective(s) or theoretical framework
- ◉ Description of the methods, techniques, or modes of inquiry, if appropriate
- ◉ Data sources or evidence
- ◉ Results and/or conclusions/point of view
- ◉ Educational or scientific importance of the study
- ◉ Clarity of language

# Manuscript Presentation

- ◉ Your manuscript should not exceed 2000 words.
- ◉ Manuscripts should be double-spaced, font 12, Times New Roman
- ◉ Include a 50-word abstract
- ◉ Bibliographies and resource list should be alphabetised.
- ◉ Headings are in bold, font 14, Times New Roman
- ◉ Authors and affiliation: on the right upper corner, authors' names titles or qualifications, Institutional affiliation on the third line
